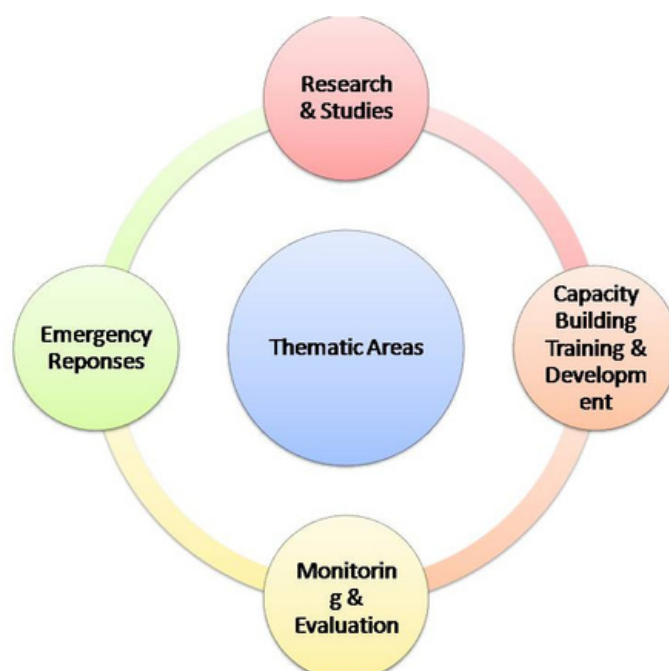

EARLY CHILDHOOD CARE TRAINING TO TEACHERS
